3 Final Review: Academic degree, professional title, and publications' criteria

A: Do the academic degree and professional title meet the criteria for an ACID?

Adjunct Professor, Assistant Professor, Associate Faculty, Associate Professor, Doctorate Student/Research Assistant, Lecturer/Senior Lecturer, MD, PhD, Post Doctoral Researcher, Professor, Professor Emeritus/Professor Emerita, Researcher, or Senior Researcher

B: Do the published original articles meet the criteria for an ACID? ACID applicants must have published one or more original and innovative article/s as the first or corresponding author in a peer-reviewed academic journal.

4 Release: Scholars who are formally accepted will be assigned an ACID logo, ACID code, and personal website. Our team highly recommends to scholars who have received the ACID code and personal website that they cite them extensively in their personal signatures.
